Provide 1:1 behaviour therapy for children with autism and/or social communication difficulties.

Run Speech and Language, Occupational Therapy and Behaviour Therapy programmes.

Take daily data on behaviour and progress.

Update targets and one plans.

Host 6 weekly parent meetings, attend TAC meetings and annual reviews.

Plan activities and make resources for your key child/children.

Run small group activities.
